Atomic Tourism: A Case Study of Place Identity

© 3 weeks (3 ECTS)

🛗 July 15 - August 2

A unique summer programme to see from up close and participate actively in a process of one city redefining its place identity. During the course, the students will study about, visit and interact with the local communities of Visaginas, a satellite town of Ignalina Nuclear Power Plant (INPP) in the east of Lithuania, famous for its forests and lakes. The lectures and field activities of the course will focus on the developmental processes of Visaginas and INPP, nuclear tourism, memory and identity in the Soviet past, transformation of city identity, nuclear media discourses after the closure of the INPP, authenticity and performance of cultural identities in tourism; educational aspects of nuclear tourism; sites, objects and museums; commodification of cultural identities and/or empowerment of local communities.

Creative Media Lab

② 2 weeks (3 ETCS)

Creative Media Lab invites you to get both theoretical background and hands-on experience and become acquainted with various contemporary media forms. In small teams, students use professional filmmaking equipment and create a documentary short film. The groups will be constantly guided by experienced professionals.

Personal Branding: forming & managing your image

② 2 weeks (3 ECTS)

In the times of strong competition in the labour market, it is necessary to understand and learn how to create and manage a solid personal image in both real and digital world. Your real life and digital style, ethics, rules and tactics of private and public communication, and the ability to create networks will allow you to design a unique and outstanding brand which will not stay unnoticed.

4 weeks (6 ECTS)

© 2 weeks (3 ECTS)

NATURAL SCIENCES

For great minds who want to improve their professional skills in the natural sciences and expand their horizons from the molecular level to the variety of Lithuanian fauna.

Methods in Molecular Genetics

© 2 weeks (2 ECTS)

 July 15 − August 26

The course is a comprehensive overview of the key techniques in molecular biology mostly related to DNA analysis. It covers the techniques of DNA extraction, gel electrophoresis, PCR and restriction digestion. Upon completion of the course, the trainee will be able to extract genomic DNA from animal cells; perform agarose gel electrophoresis to analyse the DNA profile; amplify specific fragments of DNA using the polymerase chain reaction (PCR) technique; perform restriction digestion experiments and visualise the obtained data.

Variety of Animals and Plants in National parks, Natural Reserves and Zoological Museums

© 2 weeks (2 ETCS)

 July 15 − August 26

The course introduces participants to field methods and data analysis, also includes theoretical and practical instruction in both the field and the lab. Participants will gain knowledge in using the latest techniques in field methodologies and the most recent analytical tools. The course is especially suited to those interested in biodiversity assessment, especially plant, avian and invertebrate biodiversity. During the entire course participants will visit different Natural Environments in national parks, natural reserves and zoological museums of Lithuania.

SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME (SIP)

Practical and innovative approach to career-enhancement skills

∅ 5 weeks (6 ECTS)

It is an experience-based five-week internship programme, which offers students a possibility to explore world of ideas, using interactive and creativity techniques by solving real challenges of organizations. Programme is implemented by the VMU Centre for Enterprise Practice (National winner and top 3 nominee in the European Enterprise Promotion Awards, 2018).
